Subject: **New Irrigation Water Restrictions**

Due to the lack of rain and the low level of the canal and lakes, the GOIS pump stations cannot support the current amount of irrigation water being consumed by the golf courses and resident's homes.

Therefore, effective immediately, we are asking the POA's, HOA's and the residents to reduce irrigation water usage by 25%. For residents, the most efficient way to achieve this is to have your landscapers adjust your irrigation controllers to reduce the amount of time your lawns are being watered by 25%, as follows:

- You can continue to water 3x per week. As a reminder, odd number addresses can only water on Mondays, Wednesdays and Saturdays. Even number addresses can only water on Tuesdays, Thursdays and Sundays
- Have your landscaper adjust your irrigation controller clock to reduce the total amount of runtime per day by 25%. For example, if your irrigation clock is currently set to run in 10 zones for a total of 4 hours, reset the clock to run in the 10 zones for only 3 hours.

- Continue to water ONLY between 12pm and 7am. Please tell your landscaper they CANNOT WATER DURING THE DAY.
- Discontinue landscaper “wet checks” on Fridays. No water will be available on Friday.
- Do not install new grass, flowers or plantings. They will likely not survive with these watering conditions.

In three to four weeks, we should be into the rainy season and can get back to normal. If we cannot achieve our goal for reducing water usage 25%, we will have to shut down the availability of water during the day on all days and 24 hours on non-watering days.
